Middlesex County Cricket at Southgate

Middlesex have been playing a regular summer festival of cricket at Southgate since 1998. The Walker Ground, however, is named after the family that founded Middlesex County Cricket Club and provided a team that played at Lord's in 1877.

Although Middlesex normally play at Lord's, during the international match programme home games are played at Southgate and other grounds including Richmond and Uxbridge.

The Walker Ground is one of the most beautiful grounds in the country, a perfect setting for a relaxing day out, and is ideally located only 5 minutes from the North Circular Road (A406).

Alan Lee writing in the 2002 'The Times good ground guide' called Southgate "a haven from the crush of suburbia" and described the ground as "green and quaint with the cottage at the entrance and the church with its splendid spire and chiming clock".
